

A STEM-based, nonfiction picture book about inventing and perseverance (ages 6-11).

The Elephants Come Home illus. Hadley Hooper (Chronicle): a true story about animals, friendship, and trust. Winner of the Norman A. Sugarman Honor, the Keystone to Reading Award, and more (ages -4-11).

The 11:11 Wish, winner of the Southwest Region SCBWI Crystal Kite Award (HarperCollins): a funny middle-grade novel about a 7th grade math whiz who uses magic to try to fit in at a new school (ages 9-12).

The Truth About 5th **Grade** co-written with comic artist, Mark Parisi: a he-said/she-said diary and comedic story about perspective and what really went down in 5th grade (3rd-5th grade).

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


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11 Magical Tips to Make Fiction Come Alive or 15 Steps to Story

Presentation for parents, teachers, or PTOs about girls and the future of STEM careers. We will discuss why literature can help keep girls in STEM classes (adults).


Five Steps for Crafting a Compelling Nonfiction Book Proposal (writing workshop)
